Mock Wrap Skirt

Materials

- Lightweight woven fabric linen, cotton shirting, lightweight twill or denim. Yardage depends upon your size and skirt length, but I made my US size 12 foot-skimming skirt with about 2 meters of linen.
- Elastic. I used 3cm elastic.
- Thread


Preparation

Wash and dry your fabric before cutting.

1/2 hip + ease + overlap + seam allowances ength + hem Skirt panel cut two hip + ease + seam allowances Waistband cut one Skirt panels (cut two) WIDTH = 1/2 hip measurement + 4cm ease + overlap* + seam allowances LENGTH = desired finished length + hem allowance *Overlap: The more you add, the wider the skirt bottom will be and easier when you walk, but also the heavier the skirt becomes. My skirt has about 20 cm (8") overlap. Waistband (cut one) LENGTH = hip + 8 cm + seam allowances WIDTH = elastic width + seam allowances Elastic (cut one) LENGTH = waist measurement minus 5cm


Measuring and Cutting

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③ Waistband

- a) Form waistband into circle; seam.
- b) Stitch waistband to skirt.
- c) Press waistband up, fold in half and press under the seam allowance
- of second seam.
- d) "Stitch in the ditch" on the front side to close the back waist-
- band casing, leaving an opening for the elastic.
- e) Thread the elastic through the casing. Sew elastic together.
- f) Sew casing closed.
- g) Adjust gathers evenly around waistband.



(4) Hem & Embellish
a) Hem by hand or machine.
b) Embellish skirt as
desired with embroidery or trim.
